2. Video Project Update: The videography team will visit Urban Conservation Corps Inland Empire, Rancho Cielo YouthBuild, Camarillo CCC, and the Ventura Training Center. The video will be focused on student stories and visit the classrooms and worksites/training centers. Exact filming dates have not been set but will be in late September and October.
3. DASS Updates: In January 2022, the USED denied the proposed amendments to California's Consolidated ESSA State Plan. As a result, in March 2022, the Ca SBE approved the submission of a waiver to the USED to request the continued use of DASS schools to maintain the DASS modified methods for calculating the Academic and Graduation Rate Indicators. The waiver request was submitted to the ED on April 15, 2022. On July 27, 2022, the ED declined California's waiver request. It is unclear if this will ultimately affect JMCS funding or practices.
